**Applications/Nominations Are Currently Being Accepted for the
2008 Stormwater Steward Award**

The Stormwater Steward Award recognizes environmental stewardship in the area of stormwater management. Organizations, businesses, individuals, or community groups that have worked to consider the impact of stormwater runoff on the health of area waters through a specific project, practice, or event are encouraged to apply for the 2008 Athens-Clarke County Transportation and Public Works Department Stormwater Steward Award.

This year's prize for winning the Stormwater Steward Award is a \$100 gift certificate to *The Last Resort* restaurant in downtown Athens.

Nominations/Applications:

Organizations, businesses, individuals, or groups may submit an eligible activity for consideration. Submissions are also accepted by nomination. All submissions must be received by March 21, 2008.

Eligibility:

Nominated projects must have been completed between January 1, 2007 and December 31, 2007 within Athens-Clarke County in order to be eligible for the award.

Criteria:

Preference is given to nominations that emphasize one or more of the following criteria:

- The use of innovative stormwater management practices in the design or construction of a development project within Athens-Clarke County.
- The use of innovative stormwater management practices to retrofit an existing development within Athens-Clarke County to better manage and/or treat its stormwater.
- Exceptional project management resulting in reduced construction related nonpoint source pollution.
- Significant efforts to provide stormwater education to employees and/or customers/clients.
- Volunteerism and company-wide participation in watershed programs such as Adopt-a-Stream.

The Stormwater Steward Award recipient will be notified of their selection by April 1, 2008, and the Stormwater Steward Award will be presented at the GreenFest Community Environmental Awards Ceremony at the Lyndon House on April 18, 2008.
